Jewellery and Accessories Policy

Netball-2020

Blackwood Community Recreation Centre is guided by the International Federation for Netball, Netball Australia and Netball SA in regards to participants wearing jewellery and other accessories while on court.

The 2020 Official Rules of Netball - International Federation for Netball, Section 5.1.1 pg. 23 outlines that:

- (iv) Players may not wear anything that could endanger themselves or other players, specifically:
- a. No adornment or jewellery (including piercings) may be worn other than a wedding ring which must be covered with tape.
 - Players with expansion plug piercings will need to remove plugs and tape the holes left by the removed plugs
- b. A medical alert bracelet may be worn provided it is covered with tape and labelled 'medical' in case of an emergency

All other forms of jewellery and accessories not clearly specified are subject to the umpire's discretion. Umpires have the authority to prevent any player from taking court unless these rules are adhered to. This policy is enforced to ensure the safety and welfare of all participants.

Additionally players requiring glasses must wear contact lenses or prescribed sports goggles approved by umpires while on court.
